

READING FROM HOME – Accelerated Reader


Reading is of major importance for all students. At school students in Yrs 7 -10 are expected to participate in our Accelerated Reading program by reading for 15 minutes at the beginning of each English, HSIE and Science lesson.

To support this, we ask that you to encourage your child to read by themselves for at least 30 minutes each day. If your child is able to read a book that is on the Accelerated Reading list they can complete a quiz through accessing the Oliver Library page. This will also allow them to find other books.


For some students it may be hard for them to find books on the Accelerated Program – but the main thing is that they READ DAILY
