## Application Process

To Register for lessons, you will need to fill in the **application form** attached and return it to Mrs O'Brien in the CAPA staffroom by Thursday Week 11, the 12<sup>th</sup> of April.

Lesson availability is limited so get your application in early to secure your spot.

Students will also have the opportunity to apply for our music tuition scholarship where the school will pay the full cost of your music tuition. (Valued at \$600 for a school year)

To Apply for the Music Tuition Scholarship, you need to fill in the **Scholarship Application Form** attached and return it to Mrs O'Brien in the CAPA staffroom with your application form.

Only **10 students** will be chosen for the scholarship program based on their application.

Students who are selected for the scholarship will be expected to be **committed to the program**.

We are currently offering an amazing opportunity for students to have **group after school lessons with only 4 – 6 students** in the group. Lessons will commence **beginning of Term 2**.


## Application Information

<b>Who is able to Apply?</b>	Any student at Plumpton High School.
<b>How to Apply?</b>	Students will need to complete and submit an application form to Mrs O'Brien in the CAPA Staffroom, Thursday Week 11, the 12 <sup>th</sup> of April.
<b>How much does it Cost?</b>	\$15 per week (an extremely reasonable price) paid on a term by term basis.
<b>What does my child wear?</b>	Normal school uniform is appropriate.
<b>How do I find out if my child was successful?</b>	Students will be notified in writing after the submission of their application form whether they were successful or not for the program.
