NAPLAN ASSESSMENT 2021

Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 7 and Year 9 will participate in the National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) online tests in reading, writing, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy from the 11th of May to the 14th of May. Where possible, the school will arrange catch-up tests for individual students who may be absent on the day of a scheduled NAPLAN Online test in week 5 (17th may to 20th May). Catch-up tests are not permitted after Friday 21 May 2021.

Students are to arrive at school atleast 10 minutes before the start of online test in period 1 each day to log in the laptops and test the earphones. This will enable the Test Administrator to start and complete the online tests on time. All students will sit their tests according to their English classes and will need a pen or pencil for working out on paper. Earphones will be provided but students are allowed to use their own if they wish. The test schedule below shows the time, duration and type of tests.
